

I have reviewed the manuscript (revised) of Fagard, the letter with the annotated corrections, and the ESM material. I find the author's responses to the reviewer's comments to be satisfactory.

I have only one final comment on section 12.2 paragraph two, the sentence
"a further densification of the network
is not currently necessary from the orbit
determination point of view"

Strictly speaking this is true, however,
more stations (using two or DORIS channels
on board satellites), would allow a more
reduced-dynamic orbit determination to
be used for the user satellites.
This could offer benefits to model
the orbits of satellites with
complicated shapes.

The last two sentences of the
paragraph have been modified
